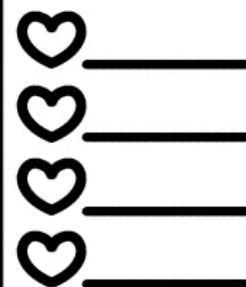
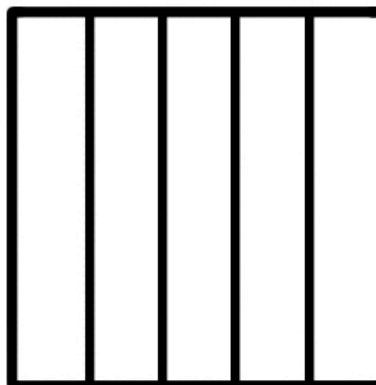


SUPPLIES: 2 SHADES OF BROWN ALCOHOL MARKER, A WHITE COLORED PENCIL, AND A BROWN ACRYLIC MARKER (OPTIONAL).

STEP 1: DRAW IN THE WOOD GRAIN USING ONE OF YOUR SHADES OF BROWN. LET DRY 30-60 SECONDS



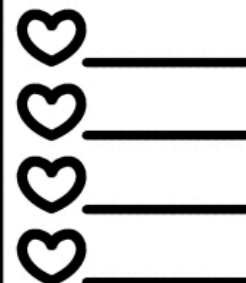
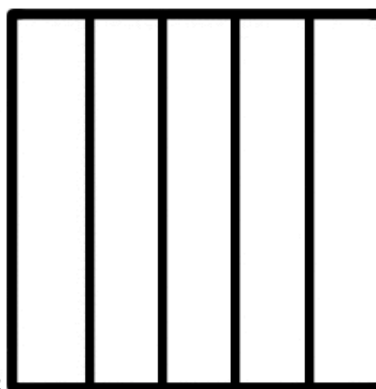

STEP 2: COLOR AROUND THE WOOD GRAIN USING YOUR OTHER SHADE. LET DRY 30-60 SECONDS

STEP 3: REPEAT STEP 2, SWITCHING BETWEEN YOUR TWO SHADES OF BROWN, UNTIL ALL OF THE WOOD IS COLORED. THEN COLOR OVER THE LINES OF THE BOARDS WITH AN ACRYLIC MARKER (OPTIONAL).

STEP 4: USING A WHITE COLORED PENCIL, COLOR OVER THE THE WOOD IN THE DIRECTION OF THE WOOD GRAIN, UNTIL IT LOOKS WHITEWASHED, BUT YOU CAN STILL SEE THE WOOD GRAIN THROUGH THE WHITE.
